STORY LINES

- The Tigers have faced off against three of the eight teams that have advance to the NCAA Championships and own a record of 4-0.

- LSU gymnastics head coach D-D Breaux owns 798 victories for her career. She needs just 2 to reach the 800-win mark during her 42 years in Baton Rouge.

- LSU gymnasts have combined to earn 10 WCGA All-America honors in 2019. Sarah Finnegan (UB, BB, FX, AA), Kennedy Edney (VT, FX, AA), Lexie Priessman (UB), McKenna Kelley (FX) and Reagan Campbell (BB)

- Finnegan is the two-time defending SEC all-around champion, SEC Gymnast of the Year and Central Region Gymnast of the Year.

- Finnegan is one of the best all-around gymnasts in school history. She is the ninth LSU gymnast to score a 9.95 or higher on vault, bars, beam and floor in a career.

- Finnegan owns the school record for beam titles in a career (27) and all-around titles in a season (13). She is also tied for the most titles in a season in school history (45).

- If LSU were to advance out of the NCAA Semifinal, it would begin on either beam (first place) or vault (second place).

- This will mark the final competition for seniors Finnegan, Julianna Cannamela, McKenna Kelley and Lexie Priessman. Over the course of their careers, the seniors have earned 122 wins, three SEC Championships, three region titles, a pair of school-high second-place finishes at NCAA Championships.

By The Numbers

LSU gymnasts have won 13 individual national championships in school history, including 12 since 2002. Returners Sarah Finnegan (UB) and Kennedy Edney (VT) won NCAA championships in 2017.

D-D Breaux

HEAD COACH • 42nd SEASON

With each passing season, LSU gymnastics continues to collect more honors and titles to its storied program, and head coach D-D Breaux has been the catalyst behind LSU's sustained success.

Led by Breaux, LSU has seen increasing accomplishments that includes 16 NCAA Championships appearances in the last 17 seasons, seven Super Six appearances since 2008 and 12 individual national titles since 2002.

Under Breaux's leadership and coaching, LSU has reached new heights in individual and team success.

Now entering her 42nd season as the mastermind of the LSU gymnastics program, Breaux exudes the same passion and enthusiasm to coach the Fighting Tigers as she did in her first season on the job.

The 2018 season marked another one for the history books as the Tigers won SEC Championships, earned 33 wins and finished fourth nationally. Sarah Finnegan took home the SEC all-around title and was named the league's gymnast of the year. LSU gymnasts earned a school record 28 All-America honors.

Breaux led the 2017 squad to the best season in school history. From beginning to end, the Tigers were masterful on the floor with 34 wins and a historic sweep of the Southeastern Conference. Ashleigh Gnat along with Finnegan and Kennedy Edney also took home the most NCAA national championships at a meet in school history with three. The Tigers ultimately finished second in the nation to match the best finish in school history.

In 2016, Breaux reached the exclusive 700 career win milestone as the team compiled a 31-6 overall record, the first time in school history LSU had reached the 30-win mark.

In 2015, Breaux guided LSU to a 13-1 overall regular season record, which included a perfect 7-0 record against SEC competition for the first time in school history.

The list of achievements in 2014 includes a program-record third-place national finish in the NCAA Super Six Finals, another individual national title by Rheagan Courville on vault, the 13th regional

title in school history, the highest score in program history on three different occasions, 20 total All-America honors including a nation-leading five First-Team All-Americans, and a then school-record 13 consecutive meets with at least a 197 score.

In 2013, LSU recorded the 12th regional team title in school history, and the Tigers reached the NCAA Super Six for the third time in 2013, recording a fifth-place finish.

In 2010 LSU reached the NCAA Championships for the ninth straight year while senior Susan Jackson became the first LSU gymnast to capture the NCAA All-Around national title, and she also won the 2010 balance beam title to become LSU's first three-time NCAA champion.

In 2008 LSU joined elite company by advancing to the NCAA Super Six Finals as Breaux and the Tigers broke through into the six-team field for the first time in program history to compete for college gymnastics' national championship. The Tigers placed fifth.

As the "Dean of Coaches" at LSU, Breaux has represented the University at the highest level both in the gym and, most importantly, in the classroom for more than 40 years. Her dedication to the student-athlete on an individual basis has transcended into academic success, community involvement, Coach of the Year honors, SEC Championships, NCAA Regional Championships and Top-10 national rankings throughout her tenure. In fact, there is a tremendous balance between academics and athletics as LSU has produced 249 ALL-AMERICANS and 150 Scholastic All-Americans during Breaux's tenure.

During her tenure Breaux has established and maintained LSU's reputation as one of the premier collegiate gymnastics programs in the country. Under her tutelage, the Tigers have placed among the nation's top-10 teams 29 times in 41 seasons, finishing a program-best second in 2016 and 2017, third in 2014, fourth in 1988 and 2018, fifth in 2008 and 2013 and sixth on four separate occasions.

Under her leadership, LSU has captured 13 individual national titles, 239 All-America honors and 85 All-SEC selections.

NOTEBOOK

Last Time Out – LSU Wins Seventh Straight Regional Title

- In the new NCAA Regional format, LSU secured the program's 30th spot in the NCAA Championships with wins over Utah, Auburn and Minnesota.
- The Tigers won their 19th regional title, including seventh-straight NCAA Regional championship.
- Senior Sarah Finnegan won the NCAA Baton Rouge beam title and McKenna Kelley won the NCAA Baton Rouge floor title.
- The Tigers finished the weekend undefeated with wins against Auburn, Arizona State and George Washington in the NCAA Second Round and Utah, Auburn and Minnesota in the NCAA Regiona Final.

Finnegan Crowned Central Region Gymnast of the Year

- Senior Sarah Finnegan was named the WCGA Central Region Gymnast of the Year for a second-straight year.
- A dominating force in the all-around in 2019, Finnegan set the school record for all-around wins with 13.
- The two-time SEC all-around champion, Finnegan clinched the Tigers' meet title with a perfect 10.0 score on floor. Finnegan has scored six perfect scores in her career with one on bars, beam and floor this year.
- Finnegan won the bars, beam and floor SEC titles in New Orleans. She tied Rheagan Courville and Sandra Smith for the most in a career with five. The Lee's Summit, Missouri, native set the school record for beam tiles in a season with 11 and set the career record for beam titles with 25.

Gymnasts Combine for Ten Regular Season All-America Honors

- Sarah Finnegan, Kennedi Edney, McKenna Kelley, Lexie Pressman and Reagan Campbell combined to earn an SEC-best 10 Women's College Gymnastics Association (WCGA) Regular Season All-America honors.
- Overall, LSU gymnasts have combined to earn 66 All-America honors in the regular season since the association began this honor in 2013.
- LSU has now combined to earn 249 regular season and meet honors in program history.

Finnegan Crowned SEC Gymnast of the Year Again

- Senior Sarah Finnegan put together one of the most dominant all-around performances the league has ever seen from start to finish in 2019 concluding with the SEC all-around title.
- The Lee's Summit, Missouri, native won the seventh all-around title in school history with a score of 39.800, the second-highest score in meet history.
- Finnegan became the sixth gymnast in SEC history to win back-to-back all-around titles.

Breaux Named Coach of the Year

- Head coach D-D Breaux was named the SEC Coach of the Year for the ninth time. Breaux also earned the honor in 1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 2000, 2005, 2015 and 2017.
- The dean of all coaches in SEC history led the squad to a record of 18-3 overall and the program's third-straight SEC championship.
- LSU has continued to improve in each week of the season and over the final four weeks leading into NCAA postseason average the squad has average a 197.900. The LSU team is the second in NCAA Gymnastics history to average a 197.900 or higher in four meets.

Finnegan Breaks Multiple Records and Closing in on More

- Regarded as one of the most consistent gymnasts in school history, Finnegan set a pair of school records to start postseason and can break even more in NCAA postseason.
- Finnegan set the school record for most beam titles in a career with 25 has increased her record to 27.
- Finnegan went from week one to 13 as the most dominant all-around gymnast in the league with 13 wins to set the school record for most in a season.
- She was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week seven times to set the record for the most in a season in the league's history.
- With her 10 on floor at SEC Championships, Finnegan joined Burkholder as the only gymnasts in school history with multiple perfect scores on three different events.
- She owns 91 career wins and 45 this season, which is tied for the most in a single season in school history.
- Finnegan finished her career as a five-time SEC champion. She tied Rheagan Courville for the most in school history.

Tigers Own Most Perfect Scores in the SEC

- LSU's Kennedi Edney, Sarah Finnegan, McKenna Kelley and Lexie Priessman are four of five gymnasts to own perfect scores in the league.
- Priessman became the first gymnast in the nation's best conference with a 10.0 when she did it on bars against Georgia.
- Finnegan scored her fourth career 10 and the nation's first 10 on beam against the Bulldogs.
- A week later, Kelley and Edney closed out the Tigers' outstanding performance against Oregon State on floor with their first career perfect scores.
- In the non-conference finale, Finnegan scored her fifth career 10 as the anchor performer on bars. Edney also anchored the vault lineup with her first perfect score on the event.
- At the SEC Championships, Finnegan clinched the program's fourth SEC Championship with a perfect 10.0 on floor.

Finnegan Named Finalist for AAI Award

- Senior Sarah Finnegan was selected as one of six finalists for the AAI Award, which goes to the top senior gymnast in the nation.
- There are six finalists for the AAI Award, which goes to the most outstanding senior gymnast in the country. Finnegan is joined by Alicia Boren of Florida, Brenna Dowell of Oklahoma, Olivia Karas of Michigan, Katelyn Ohashi of UCLA and Toni-Ann Williams of Cal.
- Considered the Heisman Trophy of NCAA Gymnastics, LSU legends Ashleigh Gnat and Susan Jackson brought back the AAI Award to Baton Rouge after outstanding careers in the Purple and Gold.

Finnegan, Edney Make History as Co-Gymnasts of the Week

- After each scoring perfect scores, winning four titles and scoring a 39.725 in the all-around win, Sarah Finnegan and Kennedi Edney were named SEC Co-Gymnasts of the Week.
- The duo became the second set of teammates in the history of the honor to win Co-Gymnasts of the Week.
- With the honor, Finnegan tied Florida's Bridget Sloan for the most Gymnasts of the Week honors in a career with 13.
- Finnegan also set the SEC record for weekly honors in a season with seven.

D-D Breaux in Historic 42nd season with LSU

- Head Coach D-D Breaux heads into 2019 as the Dean of Southeastern Conference coaches.
- Breaux, in her 42nd season as the head coach of the Tigers, has now surpassed Adolph Rupp of Kentucky basketball as the longest tenured coach in the history of the league.

- Following a 9.95 at GymQuarters, senior Sarah Finnegan became the ninth gymnast in school history to earn a 9.95 or higher on all four events.
- Finnegan joined Kennedy Edney, Myia Hambrick, Ashleigh Clare-Kearney, April Burkholder, Jennifer Wood, Rheagan Courville, Susan Jackson and Abbey Burns.
- The Lee's Summit, Missouri native owns career highs of 9.95 on vault and 10.0 on bars, beam and floor.

Gymnastics Schedule one of Toughest in the Nation

- According to RoadToNationals.com, the 2019 LSU gymnastics schedule ranks as the second toughest in the nation.
- LSU is one of 15 schools to compete in 13 meets this season and their total points of 903 ranks second behind Georgia's 946.
- The squad will face off against 12 ranked teams during the regular season, including five ranked in the top 10 and three in the top-5.

Finnegan, Kelley Earn SEC's Top Honors

- LSU seniors Sarah Finnegan and McKenna Kelley put together career performances against No. 15 Oregon State and were rewarded with the Southeastern Conference's top honors.
- Finnegan was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week for the sixth time in 2019 after scoring a career-high 39.800 to seal her 10th all-around win in 11 meets. The Lee's Summit, Missouri, native posted the highest score in the SEC and second-highest in the nation against the Beavers.
- The reigning SEC Gymnast of the Year became the fourth gymnast in school history to score a 39.800 or higher in the all-around. Finnegan joined Rheagan Courville as the only gymnast in school history to achieve the feat in a meet without scoring a 10.
- Kelley, the SEC Specialist of the Week, anchored the Tigers' outstanding performance on Friday night with the first perfect score of her career. The 10.0 marked the 25th in school history on floor. The Houston, Texas, native was the final performer of the Tigers' 49.675 fourth rotation for a season high.

Finnegan, Priessman Earn Perfect Scores Against Georgia

- Senior Lexie Priessman and Sarah Finnegan earned perfect scores against Georgia and were honored with the league's top honors.
- Priessman returned from missing three meets and scored her first perfect score and the first in the SEC in 2019. The perfect score on bars marked the fourth in school history.
- Finnegan scored a perfect score on beam, fourth 10 of her career on any event, to lead LSU to a nation's best 39.650 on beam. The performance from Finnegan marked the first perfect score on beam in 2019. She joined April Burkholder as the only gymnasts in school history with two perfect scores on beam.

Eight-Win Weekend Earns Finnegan Fourth SEC Honor

- Senior Sarah Finnegan was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week for the fourth time in 2019 following a dominating eight-win weekend at GymQuarters and at home against Missouri.
- Finnegan swept both the all-around, floor and bars titles at both meets and also won vault at GymQuarters and beam at home against Missouri.

Finnegan Once Again Named SEC Gymnast of the Week

- Senior Sarah Finnegan was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week for the third time in 2019 following three individual titles against NC State.
- Finnegan won both bars and beam with a score of 9.95 and the all-around with a 39.65.
- In her career, Finnegan has won 61 titles, including 19 on both bars and beam.

Finnegan Named SEC Gymnast of the Week After Four Wins Against Florida

- Following four titles, tying her career high on vault and the highest all-around score in the SEC, senior Sarah Finnegan was named the SEC Gymnast of the Week for a second time in 2019.

Gymnastics Boasts Impressive Run in the PMAC

- LSU is currently 40-1 inside the Maravich Center since the beginning of the 2014 season for the best five-year stretch in school history.
- The program has one of the best home records in the nation.
- In the program's history, only three senior classes have finished their careers inside the Maravich Center with a perfect record. The other stretch came from 1975-78 and 2014-17.

Finnegan Named Gymnast of the Week to Open Season

- LSU senior Sarah Finnegan opened the season by being named the SEC Gymnast of the Week after her performance against No. 8 Cal.
- Finnegan took home the beam, floor and all-around titles against the Bears to push her career total titles to 49. Her total titles rank 10th in school history.
- A year ago, Finnegan earned five SEC Gymnast of the Week honors.

Kelley Returns to Floor Following Achilles Injury

- Senior McKenna Kelley has returned to competition after missing the entire 2018 season. Kelley suffered an Achilles injury during training in November 2017.
- Kelley returned to the floor lineup against Cal and scored a 9.90. She was injured during floor warm ups at Auburn and is questionable for the Tigers' meet against Florida.

Jeanie Beadle

1977 AIAW Balance Beam National Champion

A pioneer in LSU gymnastics history, Jeanie Beadle won the Tigers' first individual national championship, claiming the AIAW beam title in 1977. She competed for LSU from 1976-80 and earned All-America status in 1977 and 1978. Her national title marked the first individual title for any female student-athlete in LSU history, and her All-America honors were also a first for a female student-athlete at LSU. As the leader of the team during her career, Beadle guided the Tigers to three straight first-place finishes at the AIAW Regionals. For all her accomplishments and firsts at LSU, the Baton Rouge native was inducted into the LSU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1999.

Nicki Arnstad

2002 NCAA Floor Exercise National Champion

Nicki Arnstad capped an exceptional four-year career by winning the NCAA floor title at the 2002 national championships in Tuscaloosa, Ala. In the final performance of her career, Arnstad tallied a 9.950 to claim LSU's first NCAA individual national title. She earned a total of four All-America honors during her career as she was recognized twice on the floor and twice in the all-around. Also a two-time First Team All-SEC performer, she still shares the school record on the floor exercise (10.00), posting the perfect score twice during her senior season including at the NCAA Central Regional to lead LSU to the NCAA Championships.

April Burkholder

2006 NCAA Balance Beam National Champion

One of the most decorated gymnasts in LSU history, April Burkholder ended a stellar four-year career by winning the national beam title at the 2006 NCAA Championships. In her final meet as a Tiger, Burkholder posted a 9.9125 on the beam in Corvallis, Ore., to become LSU's second beam national champion. She recorded a school record 14 All-America honors during her career and was named to the All-SEC team four times. Burkholder was also selected as both the NCAA Central Region and SEC Gymnast of the Year twice (2004 and 2005) and was named the SEC Freshman of the Year in 2003. She is also second in school history with eight perfect 10.00's and the only Tiger with at least one on three different events - scoring four on floor, two on vault and two on beam.

Ashleigh Clare-Kearney

2009 NCAA Vault National Champion

2009 NCAA Floor Exercise National Champion

Ashleigh Clare-Kearney finished her outstanding career April 18, 2009, by becoming LSU's first two-time national champion as she captured the vault national title with a 9.900 average and the floor national title with a 9.950 score in Lincoln, Neb. The five-time First Team All-American capped her senior season by earning NCAA Central Region Gymnast of the Year recognition, and she recorded her third straight First Team All-SEC honor after repeating as SEC Floor Exercise Champion. She was also the SEC Gymnast of the Year as a junior as she became LSU's second SEC All-Around champion in 2008. Clare-Kearney ended her career as LSU's all-time leader in individual titles as she finished with 114, and she was instrumental in leading the Tigers to back-to-back NCAA Super Six appearances in 2008 and 2009.

Susan Jackson

2008 NCAA Vault National Champion

2010 NCAA Balance Beam National Champion

Susan Jackson became LSU's first gymnast to win a national title before her senior season as she earned the vault national title with a 9.8563 average as a sophomore at the 2008 NCAA Championships in Athens, Ga. After finishing as national runner up on vault in 2009 behind Ashleigh Clare-Kearney, Jackson went out on top as a senior in 2010 by capturing two more national titles to become LSU's first three-time champion. She tallied a 39.625 all-around score at the NCAA Championships in Gainesville, Fla., to earn LSU's first All-Around national title, and two days later she punctuated her career with a near-flawless performance to earn the beam national title with a 9.9625 score. Displaying consistency all season as a senior, Jackson was named the SEC Gymnast of the Year and NCAA Central Region Gymnast of the Year, and she became the first LSU gymnast to receive the prestigious AAI Award and Gymnastics Honda Sports Award that both go to the nation's top gymnast. Jackson further cemented her legacy by winning 11 all-around titles in 2010, breaking a 30-year-old school record for the most in a single season.

Rheagan Courville

2013 NCAA Vault National Champion

2014 NCAA Vault National Champion

Rheagan Courville capped one of the best seasons in LSU history by winning the vault national title on April 21, 2013 inside Pauley Pavilion in Los Angeles, Calif. Courville performed a fantastic vault to score a 9.9250 and take home the title. Her sophomore campaign in 2013 will go down as one of the finest in LSU gymnastics. She won SEC Gymnast of the Year and became the first Tiger gymnast to win three titles at one SEC Championship as she captured the vault, beam and all-around titles. Courville was also named the NCAA Central Region Gymnast of the Year after she led the nation with nine all-around victories in 2013. She became the first LSU gymnast in history to repeat as national champion in an event as she captured the 2014 NCAA vault national title. Courville earned the highest score on vault ever in the NCAA Individual Event Finals competition with a 9.9750 to win the national title on April 20, 2014 inside BJCC Arena in Birmingham, Ala. The national title capped another fantastic season for the Baton Rouge native. In 2014, Courville earned Central Region Gymnast of the Year honors for the second straight year, finished No. 2 nationally in the all-around rankings, tallied eight All-America honors including multiple first-team honors on vault and the all-around, and she became only the fourth gymnast in school history to record two or more perfect 10 scores on vault in her career.

Ashleigh Gnat

2017 NCAA Floor National Champion

Ashleigh Gnat finished one of the most successful careers in school history by winning the floor title on April 15, 2017 inside Chaifetz Arena in St. Louis, Missouri. Gnat totaled a 9.9625 in the anchor spot of the Tigers' floor lineup that set a school record with a score of 49.7125. Gnat was named the Southeastern Conference Specialist of the Year and NACGC Central Region Gymnast of the Year for a second-straight season. The Lake Mary, Florida native was also selected as the winner of the 2017 AAI Award, which is given to the nation's top senior gymnast and a finalist for the Honda Award. Gnat finished her career as a four-time SEC Champion and 17-time All-American. She set multiple school records, including the most floor titles in a single season in school history (12) and tied for the most perfect 10.0 scores in a career with nine.

Kennedi Edney

2017 NCAA Vault National Champion

Kennedi Edney made her mark as a consistent performer on three events and ended the season in style as the NCAA vault champion. Edney stuck her 1 1/2 vault for a score of 9.9875 at the national championship meet on April 15, 2017 inside Chaifetz Arena in St. Louis. Edney's score marked the highest by an LSU gymnast ever at an NCAA Championship. The Chino, California native became the first freshman national champion in school history. Edney completed one of the most consistent seasons in school history as she became just the second gymnast in school history to earn a score of 9.925 or better on all four events. Edney was named to the All-SEC freshman team and earned two All-America honors.

Sarah Finnegan

2017 NCAA Bars National Champion

Sarah Finnegan became the third sophomore in school history to win a national title as she captured the bars national title with a 9.950 at the 2017 NCAA Championships in St. Louis, Missouri. Finnegan became the first NCAA champion on bars in school history in front of her home state. Finnegan ended the season with five All-America honors, including four at the NCAA meet on bars, beam, floor and All-Around. During the Super Six finals, Finnegan shattered her previous career high in the all-around with a 39.625 to tie for the highest score at the NCAA Championship in school history.
